The state of California has extended the FAFSA and CADAA priority filing deadline an additional month to May 2, 2024. Seniors who have not completed your FAFSA or CADAA already, make sure to meet this priority deadline to be considered for the maximum amount of aid.

Community Service Hours

UHS offers the opportunity to show you've performed 25 hours or more of community service during the year with a notation on your official transcript.
