IUSD requires students applying for a parking permit to attend the "Smart Start" driving presentation hosted by the IPD (FYI: students, grades 9-12, may participate in the presentation before or after receiving their driver's license). Security will check eligibility (attendance and smart start completion) and if eligible, you will receive a confirmation email stating you are cleared to pay.
