Mandatory E-Vehicle Safety and Permit

Parking Permit

Parking permit is required for you to park on campus. Parking without permit will be booted. IUSD requires students applying for a parking permit to attend the "Smart Start" driving presentation hosted by the IPD (FYI: students, grades 9-12, may participate in the presentation before or after receiving their driver's license). Fill out the parking permit application, found here. Print the email confirmation sent to you. Submit the signed form to the front office. Security will check eligibility (attendance and smart start completion) and if eligible, you will receive a confirmation email stating you are cleared to pay. Once you have paid, security will apply the parking permit to your vehicle.
