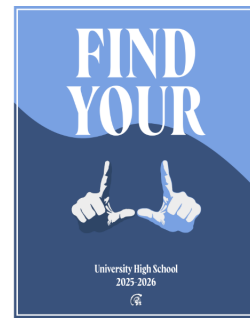

### Mandatory E-Vehicle Safety and Registration

### Parking Lot Procedures

Parking permit is required for you to park on campus. Parking without permit will be booted. IUSD requires students applying for a parking permit to attend the "[Smart Start](#)" driving presentation hosted by the IPD (*FYI: students, grades 9-12, may participate in the presentation before or after receiving their driver's license*). Fill out the parking permit application, found [here](#). Print the email confirmation sent to you. Submit the signed form to the front office. Security will check eligibility (attendance and smart start completion) and if eligible, you will receive a confirmation email stating you are cleared to pay. Once you have paid, security will apply the parking permit to your vehicle.
