Parking Lot Procedures

IUSD requires students applying for a parking permit to attend the "Smart Start" driving presentation hosted by the IPD. Parking Applications will be done online. Accurately complete the form found here. Print the email confirmation sent to you. Submit the signed form to the front office. Security will check eligibility (attendance and smart start completion) and if eligible, you will receive a confirmation email stating you are cleared to pay. Once you have paid (\$50/semester), security will apply the parking permit to your vehicle.
