- * = Non-academic Course

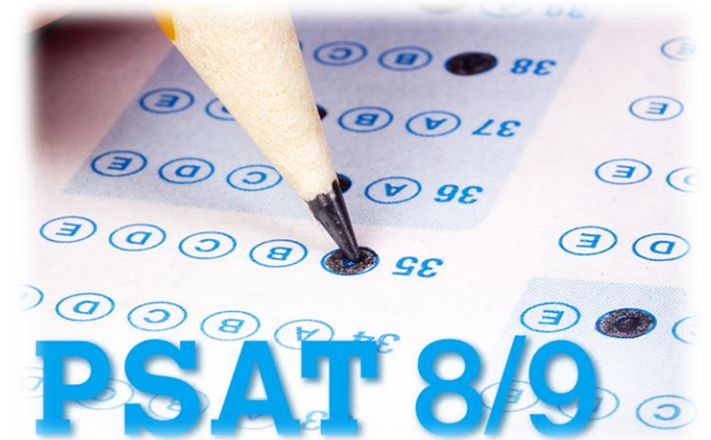
Academic GPA = Only College Prep Courses

 - Offered to ALL Freshman in IUSD
- When?
 - Wednesday, April 11th (7:30am-10:05am)
 - Pre-admin – Tuesday, April 10th (8:00-8:35)
- What?
 - Helps 9th graders determine their strengths/areas of improvement are so they are ready for college when they graduate
 - 2 hours and 35 minutes
 - Components: Reading, Writing and Language, Math
 - Aligns with 9th grade curriculum
 - After the test: Students can upload their test results to Khan Academy so they can have personalized practice in areas where they can improve
 - Test is for practice ONLY

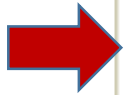
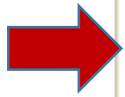
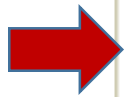

AP US History

- Automatic recommendation from Honors- 90%
- Automatic recommendation from College Prep-92%
- To take the DBQ-86% (Fall)
 - DBQ test – Thursday, April 26th (7:15-8:30am)

Honors English 2

- Refer to the UHS course catalog for specific pre-requisite skills and criteria
- Students will be receiving English course recommendations during the week of 4/9
 - Students should be speaking with their teachers regarding placement
 - Placement Test – Wednesday, April 18th (7:00-7:50am)

English Dept. Course Catalog

Successful Honors/AP English Students have the following prerequisite skills:

- The student completes assignments, including reading, on time.
- The student actively engages in class on a regular basis.
- The student seeks and applies constructive criticism to improve performance.
- The student's writing consistently demonstrates understanding of grade level curriculum.
- The student's writing demonstrates control of the English language (syntax, diction, grammar, punctuation, etc.).

Criteria for English Honors/AP Placement

Current Course Enrollment	Criteria	Placement Process
UHS English Honors or AP English course	Student regularly demonstrates prerequisite skills, earns B's or higher on summative essays, and has teacher recommendation.	May enroll in Honors English or AP English.
UHS English Honors or AP English course	Student regularly demonstrates prerequisite skills, earns B-'s on summative essays, and has teacher recommendation.	1. The student meets with current Honors/AP English teacher to verify that the student has demonstrated the prerequisite skills identified above for Successful Honors/AP English Students. 2. The student takes a placement exam to determine the course best suited for student success.
UHS CP English course	Student regularly demonstrates prerequisite skills, earns A's on summative essays, and has teacher recommendation.	May enroll in Honors English or AP English course.
UHS CP English course	Student regularly demonstrates prerequisite skills, earns A-'s on summative essays, and has teacher recommendation.	1. The student meets with current Honors/AP English teacher to verify that the student has demonstrated the prerequisite skills identified above for Successful Honors/AP English Students. 2. The student takes a placement exam to determine the course best suited for student success.
Students transferring from another school	Most recent Honors/AP English course grade is A. Most recent English course has a strong literary analysis and writing component.	1. The student meets with his/her counselor who verifies that the student has the academic record to be successful in an Honors or AP English course at UHS. 2. The student takes a placement exam to determine the course best suited for student success.
