

FRESHMAN PRIORITY REGISTRATION

The Freshman Priority Registration (FPR) program is for high school seniors planning to attend Orange Coast College in Fall 2016. The program offers seniors the opportunity to receive an early registration date and access to exclusive programs.

COMPLETE THESE STEPS BY MAY 14, 2016:

1. APPLY TO OCC!
2. ONLINE ORIENTATION
3. PLACEMENT TESTING
4. STUDENT EDUCATION PLAN

FPR EXCLUSIVE PROGRAMS

NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION

Register for classes in person and earlier than most of your peers! Sign-up in advance for New Student Registration, held during the week of June 18–25 and receive academic advisement from counselors, learn about programs and services, and register for classes.

NAVIGATE OCC

Prepare for a successful first day and beyond! Sign-up in advance for Navigate OCC, held on August 23–25, to learn about student life and how to get involved, go on a campus tour and buy your books.

PLAN AHEAD!

Students must complete the enrollment steps by May 14, 2016.

FRESHMAN PRIORITY REGISTRATION

► *Fall 2016 Enrollment Steps*

STEP 1

APPLY for Admission (REQUIRED)

- Begin to apply for Fall 2016 on November 30 at www.orangecoastcollege.edu/applynow. After the application has been processed (allow 3-7 business days), you will receive a confirmation email from admissions with your student ID # and login information for your MyOCC account.

APPLY for Financial Aid (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED)

- Starting January 2, complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at <https://fafsa.ed.gov>.
- For AB 540 eligible students: complete the Dream Act Application at <https://dream.csac.ca.gov>

STEP 2

Complete an ORIENTATION (REQUIRED)

- The orientation will introduce you to OCC, its services and programs, policies, and expectations. Access the online orientation 24/7 through your MyOCC account.

STEP 3

Complete PLACEMENT TESTING (REQUIRED)

- Take the placement test at your high school (check with your career center to see if OCC is coming your school). OR, take the placement test at OCC's Assessment Center. Visit www.orangecoastcollege.edu/FPR for testing hours.
- Ensure that you are prepared for the placement test by reviewing test prep materials at www.orangecoastcollege.edu/FPR.

STEP 4

Complete STUDENT EDUCATION PLAN (REQUIRED)

- After you complete the placement test, you will be assigned a date to attend a Student Education Plan workshop at OCC or at your local high school. If you cannot attend your scheduled workshop, please contact us.

FAST FORWARD

Running out of time to complete the steps? Too busy to attend any of the testing dates at your school? Live too far to visit OCC regularly? Then Fast Forward is for you! During each Saturday starting on April 16, you will be able to complete steps 2-4 at OCC all in one day! You must sign up in advance at www.orangecoastcollege.edu/FPR to participate.

REGISTER for CLASSES (REQUIRED)

- After you complete steps 1-4 by Saturday, May 14, 2016, you will have two options to register for classes: Sign-up and attend New Student Registration **OR** register online through your MyOCC account.
