Sign up to take the PLAN (pre-ACT) in October.
Continue to focus on your academic classes and try the best that you can.
The career and college center advisor will set up class meetings for you to take a career interest inventory. Discuss results with career advisor, school counselor and parents.
In Spring, sophomore counseling begins. You will meet with your school counselor for 45 minutes and discuss an individual academic plan. The counselors will also discuss post high school options. Your parents will receive an appointment time in the mail. Conferences start at the end of February and continue until May.
Start researching colleges or universities on-line.
Visit college campuses and attend college and career fairs.
Continue your extracurricular activities.
Enroll in summer school, if necessary.
Plan summer activities: (internships, volunteer work, community college classes, etc).
