Academic Honesty

Students

The Board of Education believes that academic honesty and personal integrity are fundamental components of a student's education and character development. The Board expects that students and staff will demonstrate organizational values of integrity, collaboration, learning, empowerment and trustworthiness.

Students, parents/guardians, staff and administrators shall be responsible for creating and maintaining a positive school climate that encourages honest and ethical behavior. Based on IUSD Continuous Improvement Efforts, students who are involved with academic honesty violations will be provided the opportunity to learn from infractions through consequences, interventions and support in order to preserve the integrity of our academic institutions.

Practices at school sites will include clear standards of academic honesty, methods for preventing academic honesty infractions, and a progressive continuum of possible consequences for different levels of infractions. These shall be incorporated into the school's expectations for student conduct.
