# Earning High School Credits

How many credits will you get for passing a class for one semester?

**5 Credits**

What is the minimum grade needed to pass a class?

**“D-”. An “F” receives no credit**

**A student taking 6 classes per year...**

*6 Classes x 5 Credits per semester = 30 credits per semester*

*2 Semesters x 30 credits per semester = 60 credits per year*

*60 credits x 4 years = 240 credits possible*

# Grade Point Average (GPA)

**A = 4.00** worth 4 points

**B = 3.00** worth 3 points

**C = 2.00** worth 2 points

**D = 1.00** worth 1 point

**F = 0.00** worth 0 points



- **Add them up and divide by total number of classes**
- **All AP courses, some Honors courses (Enhanced Math 3 and H Chemistry), and a level 4 World Language are weighted**
