

8th grade teacher recommendations available on Aeries: Friday, April 15th

★ Students and parents will see their current teacher recommendations in Aeries. Teachers can change these until the last day of school. Summer school may alter any recommendations or placement as well.

★ UHS counselors will be available in person at Rancho Middle School to clarify the course selection process and answer any parent questions about the transition to high school.

9th grade course selection: Wednesday, April 20th to Monday, April 25th

★ Students will receive a Google form link to choose courses for 9th grade. All course requests are due on Monday, April 25th. Students will not be able to view these courses in Aeries until early August. The form will verify your responses via email once completed.


