Academics

- Encourage your students to do their best.
- Check in with them to see how they are doing (AERIES.net is a great tool for this.).
- 9th Grade can be a transition to empower our students...slowly release ownership of their life and choices to them.
- Issues with teachers should be attempted to be resolved in the following order:
 - Student with teacher
 - Student and parents with teacher
 - Student and parents with teacher and administrator.



Attendance



- Students must be on time.
 - There are consequences for students who are tardy. See the <u>Trojan Code</u> on the UNI website for further information.
 - Plan on arriving to school 10-15 minutes early.
 - Parking lot gets very busy.
- Checking in & out of school must be done at the Attendance Window.
- If absent, you have 3 days to clear the absent.
 - Try to get into the practice of calling in the day of the absence
- If your student attends a doctor's appointment, they must return the following day with a doctor's note.
- Check in on your student's attendance periodically (AERIES.net is a great tool for this.).

Parking, etc.

- If possible, avoid last 15 minutes before school begins

- Visitor's parking
- Traffic Flow

(Marked with blue lines) Spaces available in all parking lds


*Please park in the appropriate parking lot. Violations may result in losing your privilege to park on campus.
