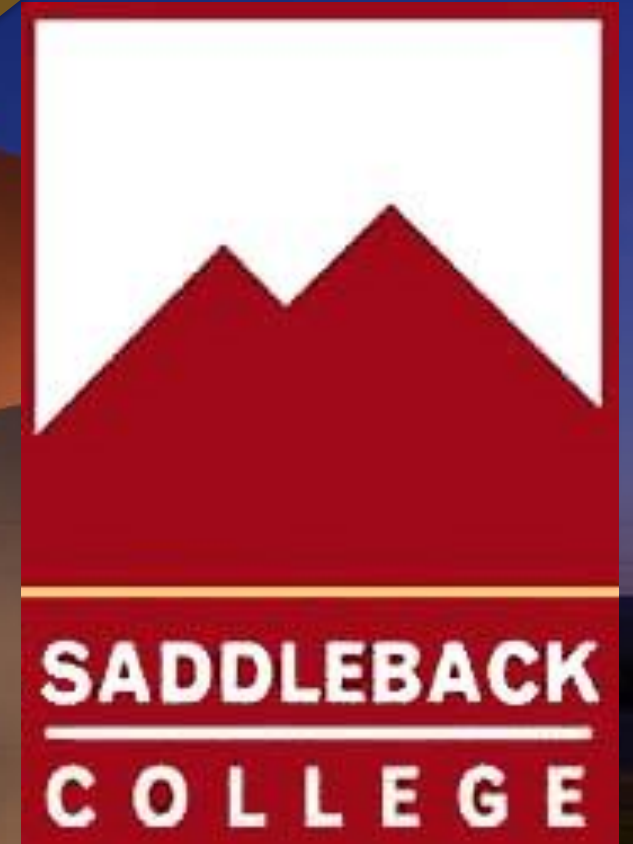

# COMMUNITY COLLEGE

## Top Reasons to Attend a Community College:

### ✓ Cost

- Approx. \$1,104 per year for tuition
- Promise Program (two years free tuition for CA residents)

### ✓ Transfer Rates and Programs (TAG/TAP)

### ✓ Undecided on Major

### ✓ Good teaching and small class sizes

### ✓ Honors Program

### ✓ Students can mature and improve study skills

- **GPA (Grades 10 and 11 for eligibility)**
- **Rigor of course schedule (AP/Honors)**
- **Personal Insight Questions**
- **Extracurricular activities**
- **Special talents, achievements and/or awards**
- **Academic accomplishments in light of life experiences and special circumstances**



# PRIVATE COLLEGES

## WHAT TO CONSIDER WHEN APPLYING:

- Private colleges can offer generous financial aid packages
- Every school has different requirements
  - Research requirements for colleges you're interested in
- Most schools accept the Common Application
  - [www.commonapp.org](http://www.commonapp.org)
- Letters of recommendation from teachers
- Counselor recommendation packets if required

# OUT-OF STATE

## WHAT TO CONSIDER:

- Merit/Need-based scholarships to offset out-of-state fees
- Pay reduced tuition and fees through Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)

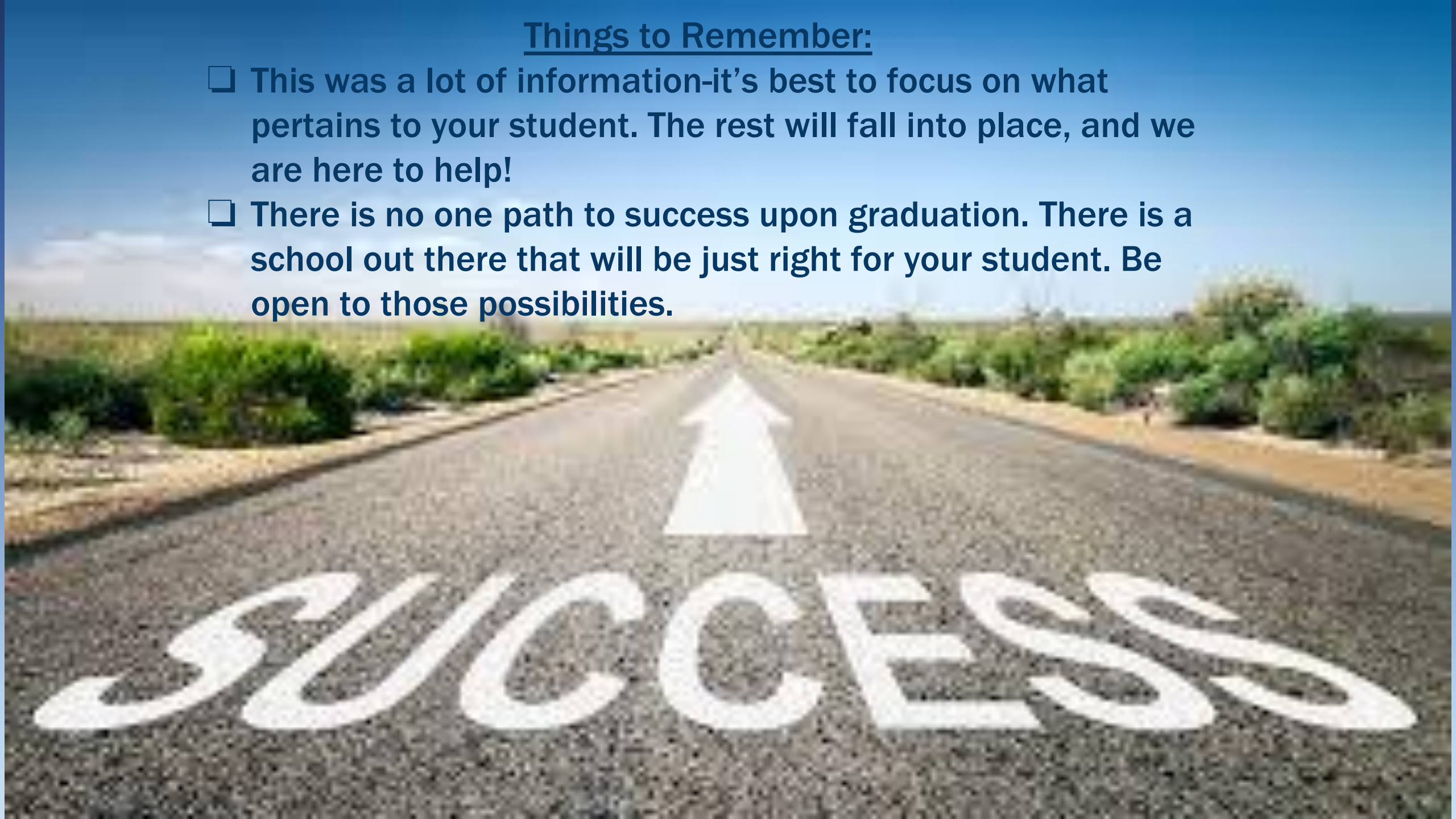
