



Top Reasons to Attend a Community College:

- **√** Cost
  - Approx. \$1,104 per year for tuition
  - Promise Program (two years free tuition for CA residents)
- √ Transfer Rates and Programs (TAG/TAP)
- √ Undecided on Major
- √ Good teaching and small class sizes
- **√** Honors Program
- √ Students can mature and improve study

#### WHAT TO CONSIDER WHEN APPLYING:

- Private colleges can offer generous financial aid packages
- Every school has different requirements
  - Research requirements for colleges you're interested in
- Most schools accept the Common Application
  - www.commonapp.org
- Letters of recommendation from teachers
- Counselor recommendation packets if required

#### **OUT-OF STATE**

#### WHAT TO CONSIDER:

- Merit/Need-based scholarships to offset out-of-state fees
- Pay reduced tuition and fees through Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)
