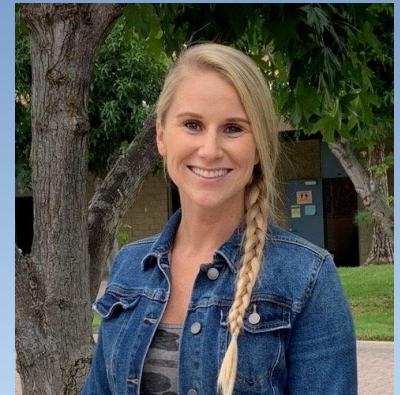



# IVC Steps to Complete Matriculation

- **Step 1: Apply for admission to IVC (required)**
- **Step 2: Submit Transcripts**
  - Self-Guided Placement
- **Step 3: Apply for Financial Aid**
- **Step 4: Orientation**
- **Step 5: Advisement/First Semester Plan**
- **Step 6: Register for Classes**



**All steps need to be completed by mid-April for Freshman Advantage Program**

# CSU Overview

- **23 campuses**
- **2.5 GPA minimum needed to apply**
  - 2.4 - 2.0 may be considered for admission based upon supplemental factors
- SAT/ACT scores not considered for admission
- **Campus impactation**
  - Results in more selective admission criteria
  - 3 categories : non-impacted, some majors impacted, impacted in all majors
- **Campuses not impacted (22-23)**

# CSU Application



- **One application for multiple schools**
  - <https://www2.calstate.edu/apply>
  - Grades are SELF-REPORTED → do not send transcript at time of application
  - If your student is reporting SAT/ACT scores for placement purposes (after enrollment), they must submit official test scores
  - No letters of recommendations needed/accepted
- **Filing period: October 1st - November 30th (Due November 30th!)**
  - After application has been submitted, student will receive an email from each CSU to open an account.
    - Check account on a weekly basis; you could miss a deadline!
    - Some CSUs may ask for a transcript after fall semester of 12th grade
- **Final Transcript must be sent by July 1st!**

# UC Application

- **Nine campuses, one application**
  - <https://apply.universityofcalifornia.edu/my-application/login>
  - Application opens: August 1st
  - Filing period: October 1st - November 30th
  - Due: November 30th
- **Do not send any official test scores or transcripts**
  - Students self-report grades and scores, and submit official information only to the UC they will attend in fall
  - SAT/ACT scores NOT considered for admission
- **No letters of recommendation accepted/required**

- Applicants will be asked to give short answers to four personal insight questions out of eight options
- There is no advantage to picking certain questions over others.
- These questions are meant to let a student's unique voice and personality shine through.


# UC Dates & Deadlines



<b>Oct 1 - Nov 30</b>		Filling Period (note: no transcripts, test scores, LOR needed)
<b>Oct 1 - March 2</b>		Apply for financial aid (FAFSA/Cal Grant)
<b>March 1 - 31</b>		Admissions Notification through campus portal
<b>May 1</b>		Student Intent to Register (SIR) Deadline (submit only one!)
<b>July 1</b>		Final Transcripts due


**Note: All campuses send out cancellations during the summer based on poor grades during the senior year or misinformation on the application**

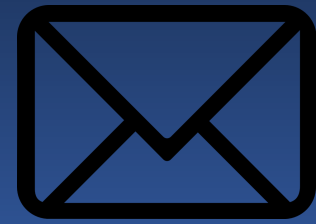

# College Recommendations



## Counselor

- Students must download the counselor recommendation packet from Canvas or UHS Counseling Website
- Please allow counselor two weeks to complete the recommendation
- If applying *EA/ED*, packet must be submitted by October 1, 2022
- If applying *REGULAR DECISION*, packet must be submitted no later than November 12, 2022

## Teacher

- Speak with each individual teacher you wish to request a recommendation from
- Ask teacher if they are willing/able to write a recommendation before you send the request on Common App
- If your teacher is using Common App/school electronic submission, request a recommendation through Common App

# Transcripts

- UC/CSU:
  - DO NOT send transcripts at time of application
  - Transcripts not required until students have been accepted and plan to attend (final transcript only)
- Schools with online portals for counselor submission:
  - Counselors will send transcript
    - i.e. Common App, Coalition, SendEdu, Georgetown, MIT
- Schools without online portals for counselor submission:
  - Student will need to send their own transcript
- How to request your transcript:
  - Option to send electronically and track through [www.parchment.com](http://www.parchment.com)
  - If schools do not accept electronic submissions, please see Mrs. Buckland to obtain an official copy to be mailed

# Check Email!



- **It is imperative for your student to read and check their email regularly!**
  - Colleges and universities will send much of their communication via email.
    - Make sure they check Spam and Junk folders!
- **Make sure they are using an appropriate email address**
  - They can't go wrong with their name; it helps colleges find their records.

# College Admissions Stress

- **Tips on how to help your student deal with application stress/anxiety:**
  - Be open and honest about college possibilities
    - Be realistic and informed
    - Know limitations (financial, geographic, etc.)
  - Offer support, not influence
    - Lend a hand with organization and helping with deadlines
  - Make sure your students are taking care of themselves
  - Some aspects are beyond anyone's control

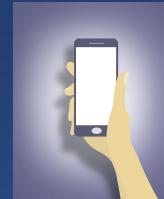
